2025 All Stars Frequently Asked Questions

Where can I obtain more information about the All Star Program?

Please visit our website, www.mvgsa.com > **League Info** > **League Documents** > **All Stars**. You can access and review all documents pertaining to the program and we highly recommend you do this prior to tryouts.

When and where are tryouts?

All-Star tryouts are Sunday, May 4th at Cal Oaks Sports Park. Check in begins at 8am and tryouts will begin promptly at 9am. Please check in at 8am so players have time to stretch and warm up. **Players MUST wear their current rec team jerseys.** We highly recommend parents print and fill out the Parent Commitment Form and Player Application and bring it with you to check in to save time. Pitchers and Catchers will participate in the tryout at 9am and then stay after the fielding and hitting portion to be evaluated on their pitching and catching skills.

Can anyone try out for the 8U-14U All Star Team?

Yes, as long as they have participated in 75% of their recreational team's season and did not drop during the Spring Season.

Why doesn't the 18U High School Team have to try out?

USA Softball does not mandate tryouts for the high school team and it is done by invite only.

How much is registration?

\$520 and that is only a fraction of the cost parents should expect to pay. All-Stars is expensive, but we encourage players and teams to obtain sponsorships to help with the expense. There have been players in the past who went out into the community and were able to have all of their expenses covered through donations/sponsorships.

How are teams formed?

Will there be a 6U Division All Star Team?

No, our All Star Program is only for 8U - High School Divisions.

Why are you combining 12U and 14U?

Our goal as a league is to put out the most competitive teams as possible. Part of this is to ensure that each team has plenty of pitching and catching. We feel by combining the two divisions we will have a stronger team. USA Softball allows players to play up so the team will compete as 14U.
